The following code refers to the behaviours expected of spectators of players of Westside Football Club.

- People play sport for their enjoyment and benefit, not yours.
- Applaud and congratulate good performance regardless of the result or score.
- Respect the decisions of officials and teach young people to do the same.
- Never ridicule or scold players -make positive motivational comments.
- Condemn violence in any form, whether it is by spectators, officials, players or coaches.
- Show respect for your team's opponents - without them there would be no game.
- Encourage players to follow the rules and officials' decisions.
- Do not use foul language, or sledge players, officials or coaches.
- Do not enter the field of play for any reason.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person, regardless of their religion, gender, ability or cultural background.
- Smoking is prohibited from all playing fields during games and training. Health WA is a sponsor of Football West - Rooball.
- Spectators are not permitted to stand at the goal ends of the pitch. Please watch from the sidelines.
